

End of Tenancy Cleaning Checklist

Kitchen:

Clean and disinfect all surfaces, including worktops, cupboards, and drawers.
Clean the hob, oven, and extractor fan, including removing any built-up grease.
Clean the microwave, fridge, and freezer (including defrosting it if necessary).
Clean the sink and tap, including removing limescale.
Clean the dishwasher (if present).
Clean the washing machine (if present).

Bathroom:

Clean and disinfect all surfaces, including tiles, bath, sink, toilet, and shower.
Remove any limescale from the showerhead and taps.
Clean the mirror and any other glass surfaces.
Clean any cabinets and drawers.
Remove any hair from the plugholes.

Living Areas and Bedrooms:

Dust and wipe down all surfaces, including tables, shelves, and cabinets.
Clean the windows (including any frames and sills), mirrors, and any other glass surfaces.
Vacuum or sweep and mop the floors.
Clean any upholstery (such as sofas) and curtains.
Clean any light fittings and lampshades.

General:

Remove any cobwebs and dust from corners and ceilings.
Clean skirting boards and radiators.
Clean any doors, including handles and frames.
Clean any staircase bannisters and handrails.
Remove any marks from walls and doors.

Additional Services (if requested):

Carpet cleaning.
Upholstery cleaning.
Window cleaning.

Please note: This is a general end of tenancy cleaning checklist, and the specific requirements may vary depending on the property and the tenancy agreement.
